Our Cabernet Sauvignon contains some of the finest vineyards from the heart of the Napa Valley. Stratton Lummis Cabernet Sauvignon is always a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon with Petite Verdot. While the percentages of each changes by vintage, the primary sub-appellations are Oakville and Rutherford. Old friendships allow us access to some very highly regarded Estates. Because we sell our wine well below the price of most Napa Cabernet Sauvignons, we have made a promise never to reveal the names of these properties.

Aromas: Dark wild berries and fragrant flowers.

Flavors: Black cherries, elegantly balanced with hints of rutherford soil.

By the Glass: Lavish.

At the Table: Enjoy with a big hand-cut steak and all the trimmings.

***A note from the winemaker:** We are a winemaker driven company. That means we make this wine because the winemaker wants to. Not because we own the property. It is our belief that the best Cabernet Sauvignon Vineyards have been privately owned since the early 1970s. As a winemaker, I could not turn down the opportunity to work with some of these estates. I am also old school and think wines should be priced fairly.*
